




TRENDS: Creating your own space


We live in a constantly evolving society, where trends become true indicators of social and cultural changes. This influences how we perceive our environment, as well as our consumption and interactions.



Trends: Economic development has turned consumption into a negative concept. For this reason, we claim what is simple; searching for the basics... In this context, the taste for rehabilitated industrial environments takes a leading role.

Spaces: The industrial trend is especially reflected in public or contract spaces, and can be seen in the decoration of shops and storefronts. It is associated with urban environments, of controlled well-studied chaos, and revolves around the taste for an industrial unfinished look. It emphasizes loft, garage, workshop or warehouse environments; or else these original spaces are refurbished for other purposes, recovering industrial elements applied to decoration.

Materials: It emphasizes plain materials: cement, lumber, metal, rust, wear, primitive, essential, basic, raw... imperfection is considered an asset. The key to this trend is the use of "raw materials" in their purest form: untreated surfaces, bare products with nothing added.







Trends: We were inspired by a look into the past, which we interpreted for you in two different ways:

Nostalgia: recovery of items with a sentimental value, which have undergone the passage of time, and that reflect it on their exterior. In any case, objects with a past. Elements that convey memories, experiences, delicacy, tenderness...
Inspiration: We adopt styles and techniques from the past, but enhanced by technology or perfectly adapted to the aesthetic requirements of the present.

Spaces: They convey an environment of romance and nostalgia, they tell a story, and have an emotional component filled with memories. We seek a retro, although updated, inspiration that reminds us of the Nordic style.

Materials: We use either old, renovated or new materials, but always functional. Retro rustic-loo-king wood with crowns, and very colourful.

Finfloor underlays extend the service life of your floor. Available in three qualities, as needed: TWIN, PE, SILENT Underlay.

- The plastic film built into FINfloor underlays protects the laminate flooring against moisture or condensation from beneath
- Extend the optimal joints condition by using an underlay with high resistance to loads and foot traffic. FINfloor underlays make up for small irregularities and uneven ground up to 2mm / l.m.


